Structure & Strategy

The course is delivered over three separate days to allow for practice, reflection and application of learning.

- Day One focuses on the skills needed to be a great coach, with an observed session and opportunity to practice and develop confidence in coaching others.
- Day Two focuses on self-awareness using the DISC® Assessment, to understand the dynamics in working relationships. Further development of skills are practised and tools are shared to enhance coaching ability
- Day Three focuses on the practical applications of coaching in school using evidence-informed models and the creation of a plan to embed coaching mindset, practices and cultures in school settings.
